

## USING USB FOOT CONTROL PEDALS

We have five USB foot pedals. They're to accompany the free Express Scribe software (there's other transcription software out there, too, but this package is reasonably well-regarded). It can be downloaded here: <http://www.nch.com.au/scribe/>. We'll install Express Scribe, as soon as possible, on all SRL and Townshend PCs.

To set up the pedals first plug the usb cable from the footpedals into the front usb port on your pc. Windows should notify you that new hardware has been detected. Next open up Express Scribe (under start-> all programs-> Express Scribe) and click the "Settings" tab. Under settings click the control tab. Under the control tab click "Foot Pedal Control Setup Wizard". The port should say "VEC Pedals USB". Follow the calibration instructions pressing the various pedals when prompted to. Enjoy your pedals are now ready to be used.

To load audio recordings into Express Scribe go to File > Transfer from Portable (Dock) > Audio Cable Method, with the DS2200 connected by USB cable. To load other files you can browse for the file name and load it by simply clicking the load icon on the upper left hand corner of the window.
